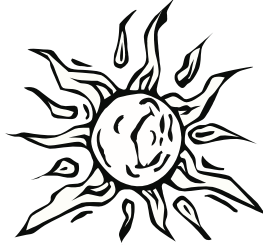


Look for

## IMPORTANT POINTS

- ☛ Simply by buying a higher percentage of our own products and services from locally owned businesses, **we can have a huge potential economic impact.**
- ☛ The least expensive product or service often is not the best investment over the long run. **Look for value and quality.**
- ☛ "Enhance the multiplier effect". A dollar spent at a locally owned business is likely to be re-spent several times before leaving town, generating more dollars worth of employment & other benefits for our community. **The profits stay here.**
- ☛ Usually located on the edge of town, **chain stores contribute to sprawl** and higher taxes for increased infrastructure costs.
- ☛ Many national chain stores are initially subsidized by local governments as enticement to locate in the community. **If these subsidies were given to local business they would enhance the local economy more directly.**
- ☛ Buying locally avoids the pollution created by transporting food and goods from afar.

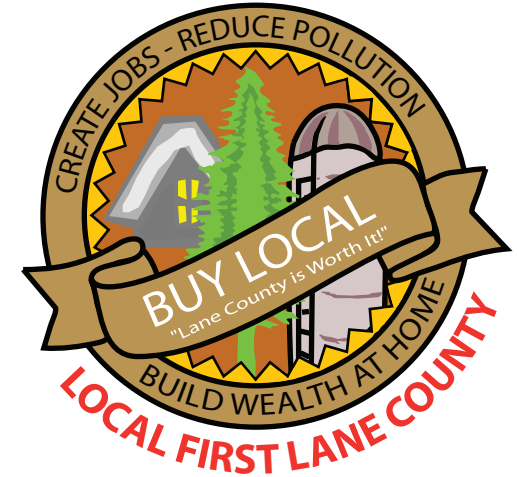
